Opening Orientation

LET'S ROCK! Please make sure you check in with Staff and make sure your group picks up safety glasses and wristbands. A staff member will talk you through the schedule and guide you to your first station

Mortar Mixing

Industry experts will explain what mortar is, how it is mixed on the jobsite, how it is distributed, and what it is used for.

3

Mud Spreading

Students will hold a trowel and learn how to spread mortar with accuracy. This station will prepare your group for the Bricklaying station by giving them the opportunity to focus on and practice their trowel skills.

4

Bricklaying

During this hour, professional masons will work hands-on with students to teach them techniques and quick trowel tips. Hands-on learning is irreplaceable!

5

Scaffold Building

This station will have a multi-stage scaffold on display, as well as a single-stage setup that will be used for demonstrations. Students may help with scaffold boards, leveling, or other tasks, as directed by the station leader.

6

Tool I.D. & Demo

Students will be introduced to the tools of the trade - including the trowel, jointer, line blocks, masons rule, etc. On display will be some commonly used materials like brick, block and stone.

Lunch will be provided. Students will break to eat and then have the opportunity to talk with industry partners and local contractors.
